## BALOO Training Available This Weekend!



The revised Camping guidelines for 2000/2001 give councils the authority to allow Cub Scout packs to conduct a pack campout (overnight) activity, as long as the activity is conducted at a council-approved location and is under the direction of a leader in the pack trained to do so. The new training course to prepare these leaders is called Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO for short).

- Designed for the adult with *minimal* camping experience.
- Learn to plan and carry out an entry-level outdoor experience.
- Each pack should have **one** Baloo-certified member of the pack leadership.
- Baloo topics include: Planning, Equipment, Health and Safety, Cub Scout Cooking, First Aid and Sanitation, Nature Hikes and Games, Stoves, Lanterns, and Fire Safety.

The training class will be held this Saturday, September 28<sup>th</sup> at the Cub Scout Adventure Camp from 8:30am until 5pm. Contact Steve Hutchinson at 288-0828 if you are interested in attending.



## Join the Pack at the Robert E. Lee Council's Dutchman Derby

This year will be a first ... a Council sponsored seasonal camp for Cub Scouts and Webelos on October 26-27 at the new Adventure Camp. Another change involves food. Meals will be provided this year, served in the dining hall, negating the need for Pack prepared meals (still bring Saturday lunch). Provided will be Saturday's supper and Sunday's breakfast. And lastly, a common campfire will be offered at the "old stage", a natural amphitheater that was used before the new camp was built. No campfires will be allowed in the pack camping areas even if you have your own raised firepit.

This year's camp will continue the program similar to last spring's "Cub Challenge." The camp staff are providing a program that allows Cubs and Webelos to earn achievements and electives, sports belt loops, and pins. Overlaying this is a "Dutchman's Derby" that is designed to test our Scouts while offering and opportunity to learn and earn achievements and electives.

Traditional family tent camping rules apply as the various camp villages will be used as activity stations and not housing. Like last spring, families can actually register and setup on Friday after 6pm instead of waiting until Saturday morning. You can choose to spend the night Friday night or simply setup your equipment and leave. This is a big help for those families with sports activities on Saturday mornings. Otherwise you can check in after 8am on Saturday but the vehicles gates will close at 11am after which time you will need to coordinate with camp staff to transport equipment in. Activities begin at noon on Saturday.

Information will be posted on the website this week. Please get registration information to your den leader by October 2<sup>nd</sup>.

BSA has announced the introduction of 9 new Academic and Sports Program belt loops and pins. They are Astronomy, Collecting, Geology, Language & Culture, Map & Compass, Flag Football, Ice Skating, Roller Skating, Snow Ski & Board Sports. The Ice Skating and Roller Skating awards replace the combined Skating award and the old Skiing award is replaced by Snow Ski & Board Sports award. Requirements have not yet been provided but will be put up on the website as soon as they are available. Still waiting for that Bocce belt loop!
